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The following points were discussed:

**•BESCOC Logo, Safety Message and Helpline numbers on Uniforms:**

GM(QS&S) informed that the cost of the embroidery is Rs.200 Per shirt - Instructed to collect the specification and call for tender and put up for approval and also instructed to include one member from textile department as a PQR member for finalization of tender documents.

**•Surprise checks:**

GM (QS&S) informed that the progress of the Surprise checks conducted by the CEE/SEEs are being received and said that the circular is not effective - instructed all the concerned officers present to conduct surprise checks and strict action/penalty shall be imposed on the erring field staff. The public would be rewarded with Rs.100/- and penalty will be imposed on Linemen/field staff who are not following the safety procedures.

**•Feeder inspections by Electrical Inspectorate:-**

Chief Electrical Inspector, Government of Karnataka, informed that they have conducted inspection on few feeders.

GM (QS&S) was instructed to coordinate with CEIG and collect the compliance report from the sub divisions concerned for the action taken on the observations made by CEIG.

**•Replacement of Iron Poles with RCC /PCC Poles :-**

Till the RC / labour contract, the targets for each division have been fixed to replace 100 poles by next meeting except for Tumkur division.
