Sub: Mandatory Acceptance of the HT application Online from Consumers

As aware, BESCOM has provisioned for the WSS portal to consumers in order make online payment. This Web self-service under RAPDRP PART-A project provides a portal that will make it easy for consumers to communicate with the utility through the web instead of direct phone calls or office visits.

This portal is currently acting as a source of information for the customers regarding policies and procedures. This in turn will improve customer satisfaction and reduce work load on the employees.

In this regard to emphasize on the customer satisfaction and make it easy for HT consumers to have a hassle-free new connection application process, the following are made mandatory from 1st July 2015.

Acceptance of all HT new connection applications is made mandatory ONLY through the bescom website www.bescom.org. Sub divisions/ concerned offices are here by instructed NOT TO ACCEPT ANY HT NEW CONNECTION APPLICATIONS MANUALLY with effect from 01.07.2015. In order to make HT application registration fees towards the same also to be compulsorily paid online by consumer, Sub division to tally the same on daily basis,

It is here by directed to SDOs to implement the same compulsorily and educate the consumers accordingly.
