Standard template for floating Tender

“To Design, supply, installation, testing & commissioning of solar rooftop grid connected power plants on the rooftop of Government/local bodies / PSU’s buildings”

Qualifying Requirements of the Bidders:

1. Proposals can be submitted by an individual company, Joint venture(JV) or consortium of companies.
2. The JV can be between two companies located in India.
3. A consortium is limited to a maximum of three companies with one company as lead bidder.
4. If the bidder forms a Consortium, it must satisfy the pre-qualification criteria.
5. If the bidder forms a Consortium, the bid shall be signed so as to legally bind all members of the Consortium, jointly and severally. A copy of the consortium agreement on non-judicial Rs 200/- stamp paper satisfying the above conditions shall be submitted with the bid indicating role and duties of each consortium member.
6. The lead member of the consortium will be designated who shall be in-charge. He shall have due authorization with a power of attorney on non-judicial stamp paper and shall be submitted with the bid from the consortium members. The lead member shall be authorized to incur liabilities and receive instructions for and on behalf of any and all consortium members.
7. Consortium members for the entire execution of the job and dealing shall be done exclusively with the lead member in-charge. He shall also be authorized to receive payments on behalf of all members.

8. In case of successful bidder, the agreement shall be signed by the Lead Member and shall be legally binding on all the members of the consortium. All members of the consortium shall, however, be liable jointly and severally for execution of the job and fulfilling the terms and conditions of the agreement.
9. In case of consortium, it would be sufficient if the prime bidder makes the remittance of the cost of bid document.
10. All partners of the consortium shall be liable jointly and severally for the execution of the contract in accordance to the contract terms and a statement to this effect shall be included in the authorization mentioned above as well as in the Bid and in the agreement (in case of successful bid). The consortium agreement should indicate precisely the role of the members of the consortium in respect of the contract.
11. Alternatively a letter of intent to execute a consortium agreement in the event of a successful bid shall be signed by all the partners and submitted with the bid together with the copy of the proposed agreement.
12. Only one Bid will be allowed from a Consortium. The partners of a Consortium are not allowed to bid individually or to be the partner of another Consortium who has also offered the bid.
13. This section covers the minimum requirements with respect to experience, capability and other particulars of the Bidder to be considered eligible for participation in the bid for the proposed work. The bidder shall become eligible to bid on satisfying the essential “qualifying requirements” and on uploading of the required documentary evidences along with the Tender.

1.	The Bidder should be Manufacturer of PV modules / Inverter or system integrator or an approved SPV channel partner of MNRE for On-grid Solar RTPV projects	Proof of necessary document should be uploaded with valid period and capacity allotted.
2.	The Bidder should have obtained the valid class-I Electrical Contractor's Licenses for carrying out the HT works/the valid class-II Electrical Contractor License for carrying out the medium voltage works, issued by the Department of Electrical Inspectorate, Government of Karnataka. In case the Bidder does not have the respective licenses, can appoint a contractor to carry-out the respective electrical works	Proof of necessary document should be uploaded
3.	The bidder company should be in existence for past 3 years	Company incorporation certificate should be uploaded
4.	The Bidder should have installed a minimum of 15 Nos. of Solar PV system with total capacity of 500kWp out of which minimum of 100kWp shall be of Rooftop grid connected Out of which at-least one system should have installed & commissioned in past 6 months	Copy of work orders and its performance certificates for satisfactory functioning of grid connected Solar PV system shall be uploaded.
5.	The Bidder should have PF, ESI, Service tax, Sales tax, Labour License issued by competent authority	Proof of necessary document should be uploaded
6.	The Bidders LOI / work awards should not have been cancelled/ short closed or The Bidder must not have been blacklisted/ De-listed by any of the ESCOMS or State or Central Government departments or MNRE as on date of submission of tender.	Necessary Self-declaration letter shall be uploaded.
7.	The Bidder must not have defaulted in supplies against any of the previous Purchase Orders placed by BESCOM/ or any other Utility as on the date of bid opening	Necessary Self-declaration letter shall be uploaded.

FINANCIAL CAPABILITIES

8.	The Annual turnover of the Bidder or Consortium shall not be less than the amount put to tender in each of the preceding three financial years (i.e, from 2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15)	Annual Report for the three audited years (2012-13 & 2013-14, 2014-15) shall be upload which consisting of a) Balance Sheet b) Profit & Loss accounts
9.	Liquid assets as on date of tender, consisting of cash in hand + cash at bank + term deposits + availability of fund based credit facility in any scheduled bank shall not be less than 25% of amount put to tender.	Availability of Liquid assets shall be supported by certificate issued by a Chartered Accountant and as regards, fund based credit facility, and certificate from any Scheduled Commercial Bank shall to be uploaded.
