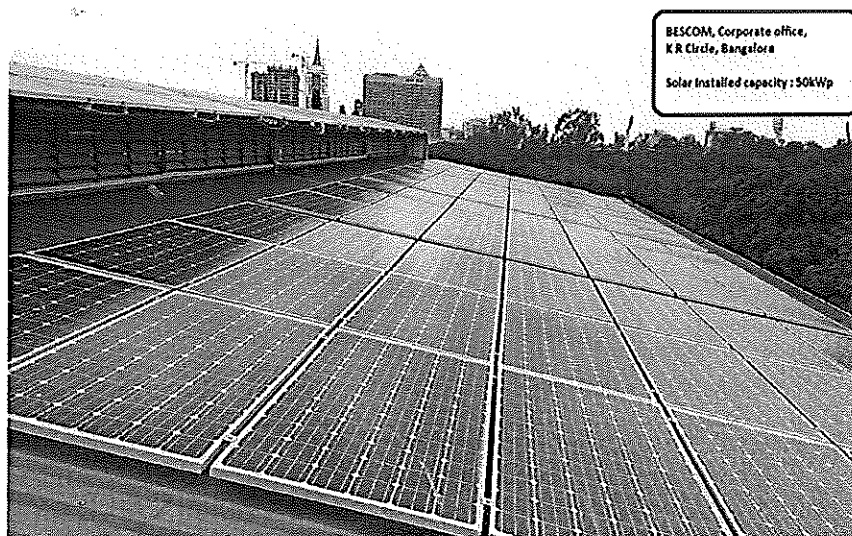


## Preamble:



Government of India's, Jawaharlal Nehru National Solar Mission (JNNSM) under the brand 'Solar India' is to establish India as a global leader in solar energy, by creating the policy conditions for its diffusion across the country as quickly as possible.

The Mission has set a target of 20,000 MW and stipulates implementation and achievement of the target in 3 phases (first phase upto 2012-13, second phase from 2013 to 2017 and the third phase from 2017 to 2022) for various components, including grid connected solar power.

Government of Karnataka, with an objective of giving thrust to renewable energy generation in the state and to narrow down the widening demand and supply gap in the energy sector, has announced the Solar policy 2014-21 on 22.05.2014.

The objective includes minimum addition and encourage distributed generation of 100 MW each year in Solar rooftop and to attain a target of 400 MW by 2018 by entire state of Karnataka.

Following the policy of GOK, BESCOM has taken up the work of implementation of the grid connected Solar Rooftop program under net-metering basis. BESCOM has invited application from all the interested consumers of residential, commercial, educational and industrial consumers with net-metering provision under which the

consumers can export surplus energy and receive payment of Rs.7.20 per unit, if MNRE subsidy is availed, or Rs.9.56 per unit., otherwise, as fixed by Karnataka Electricity Regulatory Commission (KERC) in its order on 10.10.2013 with a power purchase agreement for 25 years for those who enter the PPA upto 31.03.2018.

Accordingly, the scheme introduced by BESCOM has elicited a good response from the consumers. Continuous monitoring of the progress is in place to ensure realization of the target.

Many Government/semi Government under taking/local bodies are enquiring BESCOM for handholding for Solar installation process on their office buildings.

In this regard, the Pre-Qualification Requirement (PQR) and Technical specification have been prepared and the same is published in the BESCOM Website, to facilitate Govt./Semi Govt./Local bodies to invite tenders.

BESCOM is also contemplating to invite Rate contract for promotion of Solar RTPV on its own office buildings. In case, other department like KPTCL / KSWA etc., wants, BESCOM to take up the tender work upto finalization of bidder, the processing fee of 10% on the cost of the project shall be deposited to BESCOM.

The Tendering process and finalizing the tender, work will be taken up by BESCOM. For Technical and Commercial evaluation, the concerned department will be made as committee member and the concerned department will have to place the DWA as per the tender terms and conditions.
